Transportation and storage

Lift with care - gross weight does not exceed 8 kilograms. Store in a well-ventilated place.

Keep cool. Store locked up.

Preparation

All surfaces to be painted should be clean, dry and free from loose and flaking material. Any rust should be removed by wire brushing. Wear a suitable face mask when creating dust. Prime bare surfaces with an appropriate Primer. Special precautions should be taken during surface preparation of pre-1960s paint surfaces over wood and metal as they may contain harmful lead.

Application

Apply a minimum of 2 coats by brush or roller. Do not apply over tar based products or surfaces that can rise above 65°C. Do not overcoat with other solvent based paints as bleeding may occur. Allow 24 hours between coats.

Take all the necessary precautions when working at height.

Cleaning

Remove as much product as possible from application equipment before cleaning. Replace lid firmly. Clean equipment immediately after use with White Spirit or Turpentine Substitute. Some local authorities have special facilities for the disposal of waste coatings. Do not empty product into drains or watercourses. Do not overcoat with other solvent based paints as bleeding may occur.
